

BASKETBALL 5V5

Class division

- Men "Open Class" for all ages
- Men "Senior Class" for 40 years and over (40+)
- Women "Open Class" for all ages

Game model

- A team consists of up to 12 players.

Matches

1. The tournament will be held under the ABC Pool/CUP system to even out differences in strength between the participating teams.
 2. The teams are ranked in each pool on points, so that the team with most points is no.1 and the next-best team is no.2 etc.
- If 2 teams are tied, the games they have played together decide the result.
 - If the teams are still tied then:
 - a. Direct comparison (only wins/losses) – if two teams are tied
 - b. Difference in goals between tied teams – if more than two teams are tied
 - c. The most points scored
 - d. Coin toss

Playing time

1. Two halves are played, each of 10 min. effective time.
2. In case of a draw at the end of regular time for cup games - 2½ min. are played as extra time. Extra time will not be played for pool games.
3. 2 time-outs per team per half are allowed.

Field dimensions

15,00 m x 22,00 m (indoor venue; a traditional basketball court may be used).

Schedule

Matches will start at 9.00 in the morning and end about 17.30/18.00 on 17th -18th and on 19th the finals ends no later than 15.00!

Team Presentation

- Teams must be present at the check-in station at the sport facility 30 minutes before the start of the match.
- If the team is not on the field at the scheduled start time, they will forfeit the match.
- The detailed event schedule will be announced upon the closing of registrations.

Rules

1. Unless otherwise specified, the rules of the International Basketball Federation apply (FIBA).
2. Even a referee must apply the international rules.
3. Detailed game rules are published in the tournament program.
4. The actual playing time for each game is 4x6 minutes. Per team and game.
5. Please note that only non-marking indoor shoes are permitted.
6. Each team must nominate a responsible person (trainer, captain), who must be always be present during the match and deals with referees and the Organization Committee.

Final Provisions

- Each participant travels and participates in the Games at their own risk.
- The organization is responsible only for first aid.
- It is mandatory to always carry a copy of personal insurance policy.
